

TEACHING VERIFICATION FOR INTERIM CERTIFICATION

Through the #TEACH program, Michigan residents can receive their Interim Teaching certification. The Interim certification is good for five years. It can be converted to the Michigan Standard certification after successfully teaching for three years. The Michigan Department of Education requires that Interim certification holders provide verification of teaching for three full years within the area of certification. Individuals seeking additional endorsements must teach for at least 50 hours in each subject area during the three-year period. For those teaching part-time, 600 hours of teaching time over a five-year period are required. The completion, signatures, and submission of this form will serve as verification of the teaching time.
